In 2014, Mazzella was approached by a large Metal, Industrial Supplies, and Plastics distributor who needed help staying in compliance with OSHA and ASME inspection requirements.

The customer was challenged with inspecting their overhead lifting and rigging equipment, used in each of their facilities, on a periodic basis. OSHA and ASME define periodic as, "a documented inspection of lifting and rigging equipment every 12 months (at a minimum) and monthly to quarterly in more severe service conditions."

With over 60 locations across 13 states, and more than 70 inspections required on an annual basis, this caused a serious logistical headache at the Corporate level of the company. Corporate resources were bogged down with managing the inspection process for each facility, and had to account for:

- Varying inspection requirements at each facility
- Varying inspection frequencies for each facility
- Varying levels of in-house inspection competence
- Multiple vendors providing the same service
- Multiple P.O.s issued across the balance of one calendar year
- Non-standardized and non-centralized reporting and documentation



Fortunately, Mazzella had a dedicated business unit, Rigging Inspection Services, that only focused on performing rigging inspections and satisfying compliance requirements. With a team of certified rigging inspectors spread across the country, Mazzella was equipped with the expertise and the resources to take on this geographical and logistical challenge.



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Once the agreement was signed, Mazzella's Rigging Inspection Services team implemented a proactive and fully managed approach to the inspections process for the customer. Mazzella developed a customized process that ensured all locations, and the corporate entity, would remain in compliance. The customer realized immediate benefits from the partnership, including:

- Proactive scheduling and timely inspections that satisfied OSHA/ASME requirements
- A regionalized approach that grouped individual locations to make inspections efficient and thorough—no location slipped through the cracks
- Consistent and standardized reporting and documentation, maintained in a central location, with each location also receiving a copy of their individual inspection report(s)
- One vendor and one annual P.O.—with invoicing performed monthly against the same P.O.
- Reduced corporate hours and resources used to manage and maintain the process
